The program not only recognizes excellence but also provides a platform for women to network, share their stories, and inspire others.

The 2025 theme, "Blossoming Resilience, Standing Strong" (盛放延棉 獨當一面), symbolizes women as vibrant, resilient leaders who thrive in diverse roles, much like kapok flowers. Contemporary women face challenges with grace, showcasing their unique strength and presence.

From full bloom to the fall of its petals, the Kapok flower can be as fiery red as flames or as pure white as snow. Fly Your Career Dreams



The purpose of 'Fly Your Career Dreams in Foshan' is to broaden local students' horizons, understand the development and opportunities in Foshan within the China Greater Bay Area, and emerging industries, especially to assist the personal development of students with slightly lower learning abilities. The target is set to be local Form 4 to Form 5 students, and to help them understand themselves, explore career options, and outline their future development paths. The key directions of these activities include Self-Discovery. We can engage in assessments and reflection to help these students to identify their interests, values, and strengths, thereby enhancing their self-confidence.

After an interview in April, students will receive diverse workplace training from May to June. In July, students will be fully sponsored to participate in a seven-day, six-night corporate internship exchange trip to Foshan, allowing them to better grasp personal skills and career orientation, enhance their career planning abilities, and participate in the "Foshan-Hong Kong Student Exchange Summit" to strengthen the connections between student from Foshan and Hong Kong.
